LATHE DONATED BY DELTA/PORTER CABLE

Laurel Cook, Associate Brand Manager at Black and Decker, made arrangements to have a new Delta Midi-Lathe Model 46-460 donated to our club. A Nova chuck and the other usual accessories were included. The lathe is variable speed with two torque ranges. Both the head stock and tail stock are #2MT and the headstock threading is 1" diameter with 8 threads per inch.

It was available at the last meeting and Bob Hobbs had intended to use it for a demonstration, but he injured a finger before the meeting and was unable to do the demo.
